**From The North:** Take I-275 south to M-14. Exit onto M-14 west towards Ann Arbor. Follow M-14 west to Sheldon Road exit. Turn right onto Sheldon Road. Follow Sheldon Road for about a half mile. Turn right onto 5 Mile Road. Entrance is on the right.

**From Detroit Metro Airport (DTW):** Take I-94 west (toward Chicago) for 3.5 miles. Exit to I-275 north. Take I-275 north for 12 miles to M-14 west (towards Ann Arbor.) Take the first exit, which is Sheldon Road. Turn right. Follow Sheldon Road for about half a mile. Turn right onto 5 Mile Road. Entrance is immediately on the right.
